CONDUCT OF HOSTILITIES IN GAZA

GAZA

▶ The conduct of hostilities by Israeli military in Gaza continued to **kill and maim** unprecedented numbers of civilians; cause a catastrophic **humanitarian crisis**; **displace** virtually the entire population of Gaza, often multiple times; and **destroy** the remaining civilian infrastructure.

▶ This imposed on Palestinians **conditions of life increasingly incompatible with their continued existence** in Gaza as a group.

GAZA

▶ Any use of **starvation of the civilian population** as a method of warfare **constitutes a war crime** and **may also constitute crimes against humanity and genocide**.

▶ Israel's pattern of **killing journalists** meant that Gaza remained the **deadliest place in the world for journalists**.



Famine (IPC Phase 5) and human impact in Gaza

500K + Palestinians facing catastrophic conditions characterized by starvation, destitution and death

In August 2025, **famine was confirmed in Gaza Governorate** by the Integrated Food Security Phase Classification (IPC) and projected to expand to Deir al-Balah and Khan Younis by the end of September 2025.

WEST BANK INCLUDING EAST JERUSALEM

▶ Israeli security forces (ISF) engaged in **systematic unlawful use of force, arbitrary detention, ill-treatment** of Palestinians in detention, and **extensive unlawful demolition of homes**, all carried out with **impunity** and used to **systematically discriminate, oppress, control** and **dominate** the Palestinian people.

▶ Human rights violations by **Palestinian security forces (PSF)** also increased during this period.

ACCOUNTABILITY

- ▶ There remains a pervasive climate of **impunity in relation to gross violations of international human rights law** and **serious violations of international humanitarian law** in the Occupied Palestinian Territory, some constituting war crimes and possibly other international crimes.
- ▶ No meaningful steps were taken by Israel's justice system in relation to accountability for violations committed by **Israel's officials and/or settlers**.
- ▶ There must also be accountability for serious violations of international law, including possible international crimes, **by Hamas and its armed wing, Al Qassam Brigades as well as other Palestinian armed groups**.

OCCUPIED PALESTINIAN TERRITORY, INCLUDING EAST JERUSALEM

- ▶ Israeli practices appeared to **aim at a permanent demographic shift in Gaza**. This, together with forcible transfers of Palestinians, which appear to aim at a permanent displacement, raise concerns over **ethnic cleansing in Gaza and the West Bank**.
- ▶ Israeli practices across Gaza and the West Bank, including East Jerusalem, indicated a **concerted and accelerating effort to consolidate annexation of large parts of the Occupied Palestinian Territory and to deny Palestinians' right to self-determination**.
- ▶ Israeli practices across Gaza and the West Bank maintained a system that amounts to a **deliberate policy of physical and juridical separation intended to maintain oppression and domination of Palestinians** in the occupied West Bank, including East Jerusalem, amounting to a violation of Article 3 of the International Convention on the Elimination of All Forms of Racial Discrimination (ICERD) which prohibits racial segregation and apartheid.

RECOMMENDATIONS:

▶ PREVENT AND PUNISH GENOCIDE

Israel has a legal obligation to take the steps ordered by the International Court of Justice, to prevent acts of genocide, to prevent and punish the incitement to commit genocide, and to ensure enough aid reaches Palestinians in Gaza. All States are also obligated under international law to take action to prevent and punish genocide.

▶ END THE UNLAWFUL PRESENCE

In line with the International Court of Justice's ruling of July 2024, Israel must end its unlawful presence in the Occupied Palestinian Territory as rapidly as possible.

▶ PURSUE ACCOUNTABILITY

The High Commissioner for Human Rights reiterates his calls upon States to pursue accountability through the exercise universal jurisdiction to try crimes under international law in national courts, consistent with international standards, and through cooperation with the International Criminal Court further to the Rome Statute, and to encourage Israel to cooperate in good faith with the United Nations, including OHCHR, in line with the International Court of Justice's ruling of 22 October 2025.

▶ CEASE THE SALE OF WEAPONS

The High Commissioner also calls upon all States to cease the sale, transfer and diversion of arms, munitions and other military equipment to Israel facilitating violations of international humanitarian law and international human rights law in the Occupied Palestinian Territory.

▶ THE WAY FORWARD

Justice for victims must lay the foundation for the reconstruction of Gaza. Duty bearers must ensure Palestinians' immediate participation in governance structures to determine and shape the reconstruction of Gaza and to ensure that two states can exist side-by-side in a human rights-compliant manner. Palestinians' right to self-determination must not be delayed and made contingent on vague and indeterminate conditions.
